BACKGROUND (Includes description, background, and justification)

On May 14-15, 2018 the City issued a request to 10 qualified engineering firms for the upcoming 2019 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) application, which will be prepared for West Side Water System Improvements. The request was sent to a mail list and advertised on-line. Five engineering firms responded with qualifications briefs, which were evaluated by a City staff committee of three, using evaluation criteria and forms provided by Allen Smith Consulting.

BUDGETING & FINANCIAL IMPACT (Includes project costs and funding sources)

The City is seeking \$750,000 in Community Development Block Grant funds, and the engineering design, both for the grant proposal and for the grant project when awarded, can be taken from the grant, if funded.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION (Include possible options for consideration)

Request that the city engage with Falcon Design Engineering to generate the engineering report in cooperation with Allen Smith Consulting necessary to be included in the FY2019 Community Development Block Grant application for West Side Water System Improvements.

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SECTION 4 - PAYMENT TO THE ENGINEER

A. Payments for Services of the Engineer

1. The OWNER will pay ENGINEER for basic services performed under Section 1 for design, bidding and construction phases a fee of:

Not to exceed 8.5% of construction cost.

- 2. Under Section 2, Items A through E will be paid based on payroll cost times 2.15 plus non-salary costs times 10%. Mileage will be at \$0.55/per mile.

Mileage will be billed at \$0.55/per mile.

The inspection services are estimated not to exceed 3.5% of construction cost.

Methods and Times of Payment Β.

Payments on account of said fee for Basic Services shall be made as follows:

- 1. Progress payments shall be made monthly in proportion to services performed. The statements shall be based upon the ENGINEER'S estimate of the proportion of the total services actually completed at the time of billing. The compensation for basic services shall amount to the following percentage of the total fee at completion of each phase of work:
 - Final Design Phase 75 percent a.
 - Bidding or Negotiating Phases 10 percent. b.
 - Construction Phase 15 percent. c.
- 2. Times of Payments. The ENGINEER shall submit monthly statements for Basic and Additional Services rendered and for Reimbursable Expenses incurred. OWNER shall make prompt monthly payments in response to ENGINEER'S monthly statements.

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Fees and / or Percentages:

We are aware that engineering fees for CDBG projects are typically limited to no more than 12% of construction and we are willing to confirm this as a maximum for the purposes of this proposal. In a number of our previous projects, fees have been lower than this level, sometimes as low as 7-8%. If the City determines that it is cost effective and desires to do so, it will be possible to complete the work at a reduced fee depending on whether our scope includes:
