BACKGROUND (Includes description, background, and justification)

The city's camera system for utility lines has reached the end of its life cycle and it was put into our current SPLOST as a capital purchase.

At this time and given the amount of time expended on using our current system, the purchase of this camera system is needed due to the fail potential of our current system.

With the number of sewer calls and the future increase to our customer base, the city has received quotes on robotic camera system that will allow us to not only move quicker throughout our system during utilization but also reduce liability for human interaction in the line through its ability to navigate through "rough" terrain within the pipes themselves.

The quotes for this system were:

- P&H Supply @ \$54,175;
- JetVac @ \$106,323.55; and
- Environmental Products @ \$85,370.00.

BUDGETING & FINANCIAL IMPACT (Includes project costs and funding sources)

This is a budgeted capital purchase in our SPLOST allocation with the funding amount of \$54,175.

BACKGROUND (Includes description, background, and justification)

The Troup County Parks and Recreation Board advises the Troup County Parks and Recreation Department regarding countywide recreation facilities and programs. The Hogansville City Council appoints two city residents to this board. Members serve 3-year renewable terms that expire December 31. One member (at least) must have a child in the Troup County Recreation system.

Hogansville's current appointees are Tony Williamson and Willie Ector. Mr. Williamson's term expired December 31, 2021. The City advertised this opportunity via utility mailers, and received 5 full applications, including Mr. Williamson's, who would like to serve another term. Attached are the 5 full applications – from Keith Jackson, Monica Johnson, Charlie Karveles, Chon Terrell and Incumbent Tony Williamson – along with 4 additional expressions of interest. In the top right of each, have noted whether the applicant has kids in the Troup Recreation System, which is required in this case.
