



BACKGROUND (Includes description, background, and justification)									
The City has been invited by Georgia DOT to submit a grant application due August 15, 2024 for 14,647 linear feet of sidewalk construction along Boyd Road and Elm, Boozer, Pine, Holmes, Hightower and W. Main Streets. Boozer and Holmes Streets would also be rebuilt via full depth reclamation. The project would be funded through the federal Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) administered by GDOT. Our estimated project cost is \$2,419,410. The TAP program would fund \$1,935,528 (80% of project cost) and the City's local match would be \$483,882 (20% of project cost). \$186,100 of the City match could come from funds already paid by a developer for future sidewalks. That would make the City grant match \$297,786.									
BUDGETING & FINANCIAL IMPACT (Includes project costs and funding sources)									
\$297,786 would be needed from City funds to match a \$1,935,535 TAP grant.									
STAFF RECOMMENDATION (Include possible options for consideration)									
Staff recommends that the City of Hogansville submit a FY 25 Transportation Alternatives Program grant application to Georgia DOT in the amount of \$1,935,528.
